2	Good food, not sugary or junk food, gives good health and vitality. All hostelites are to eat the stipulated meals served by the school caterer.	Items of provision will be confiscated.
3	We hope to breed students, scholars not fighters, therefore no one is permitted to engaged in any rough play or fighting in the hostel.	Washing of curtains and disposal of refuse basket for offenders first . Subsequently, offenders will be suspended for one week from the hostel.
4	All work and no rest, make Jack a cranky lad, every hostelites is supposed to strictly observe the siesta period.	Sweeping the hostel.
5	Punctuality is the sole of business, even if that business is being a student. i. Anyone who resumes late to school after any holiday be it long or short is not operating in the spirit of punctuality. ii. Coming late to dinning hall for meals is equally prohibited.	i. Being sent back home on a week suspension. ii. Culprits will clean the dinning hall after everyone has finished eating for the day.
6	The Holy Bible says “seest thou a man who is quick with his tongue, there is more hope for a fool than for him”. The Bible is our code of ethics at The Ambassadors Schools; thus i. Talking or playing while eating is not a desirable behavior. ii. No hostelite should play, talk or cause any form of distraction while studying.	i. Culprits will clean the dinning hall after everyone has finished eating. ii. Offenders will wash toilets.
7	As good Ambassadors we must endeavour to add virtue to virtue by cultivating some daily little, little good habits. In view of this i. It is not allowed that any hostelite should play or malinge around while general cleaning is going on.	i. Culprits shall wash the kitchen tiles.

	ii. Destroying or breaking of hostel properties is not a desirable behaviour.	ii. Defaulters will be made to replace the properties so destroyed.
8	As young Ambassadors no one is permitted to use dirty or foul language either abusively on others or at play.	This will cause the offender to be restricted to his or her bed for 1 day while other students are at play or watching T.V.
9	“Neatness is next Godliness” is a popular adage. Every hostelite is expected to be neat.	Defaulter will be made to wash those cloths and some other people’s cloth.
10	Stealing within and outside hostel is a very serious offence.	Offenders will be given public disgrace.
11	Eating of another person’s food without permission is wrong.	Such a person would be deprived of two meal.
12	Careless handling of drinking water is highly prohibited.	Fetching another water in the keg.
13	Contraband items should not be seen in the hostel at all.	These items will be confiscated.
14	God in heaven is the foundation of this school and a Christian is not expected to belong to any form of cult.	Culprit will be expelled from the school.
15	The required dressing in the hostel includes; school uniform, sport, house, weekend and church wear. All forms of mufti are disallowed in the hostel.	Defaulters will have such properties seized.
16	Careless handling of personal properties is strictly frowned at.	Those properties will be seized for a period of 2 days to one week and the culprit be made to arrange properties in the hostel.
17	Disrespect to hostel master and mistress is a sin against both God and the school.	Defaulters will be made to clean the toilet.
18	Every student is expected to wash plate after use.	Defaulters will be made to clean the toilets.
19	All play and no work All students are expected to i. Copy their notes ii. Do their assignments iii. Complete their project given in school.	Feeding money of such a person will not be given to him/her until he/she completes his/her work.
